## 17. ST ALBANS PARK SKATE FACILITY

A report by the Area Parks Officer and the Community Recreation Adviser provided feedback from the consultation with local skaters and a concept design representing their preference for a facility on St Albans Park. It was noted that the design was more extensive than the temporary ramp and that this was reflected in the increased cost.

## The Board **resolved**:

- 1. That the concept plan as shown be approved and detailed drawings, specifications and tender documents be prepared.
- 2. That copies of the plan be circulated to local residents for their information.
- 3. That the current available funding of \$36,000 be used to complete the St Albans ramp and that any remaining balance go toward the Papanui Ward skate facility.
- 4. That the temporary wooden ramp be relocated at Brooklands Domain on a trial, as the preferred site in the Papanui Ward.
- 5. That consultation be initiated with a site plan showing a suitable location for a skateboard ramp on Brooklands Domain to be circulated to local residents for their comments and feedback.
- 6. That a Committee of the Board, comprising the Chairperson, Deputy Chairperson and Robin Booth, have power to act to approve funding up to \$36,000 for the ramp.
