

10. ADDINGTON PRISON - URBAN RENEWAL

The Chairman advised that he had attended a public meeting on 21 November 1999 where the future of the prison site and buildings was discussed. The Environmental Policy and Planning Unit had provided a design for use of the site as a residential development, but leaving the Lincoln Road end and main prison building in place. The Government will be offering the site to Ngai Tahu. Any development that is centred on retaining the present building will require consultation with all residents in the area.

The Board **decided** to:

1. Receive the information.
2. Request the Council's Environmental Committee Sub-Committee to invite representatives of the Board to attend any further meetings on this issue.
