19. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

(a) TRAFFIC CONTROL MEASURES

Mr A W Sparrow, 14 Vienna Street, presented a petition seeking a review of the present Council policies on traffic calming and the installation of pedestrian islands. Mr Sparrow's submissions and the petition were considered with Clause 13 of the Committee's agenda.

(b) VIEW TERRACE SAFETY WORKS

Mr Rod Whearty, 21 View Terrace, sought an allocation of funding for safety works in View Terrace. Speed of traffic and a lack of pedestrian facilities were of concern to residents. The Committee has requested investigation of the implementation of a speed limit on View Terrace and/or, alternatively, the provision of a footway adjacent to the road. The views of the Spreydon/Heathcote Community Board will be sought.

(c) SHIRLEY/PAPANUI COMMUNITY BOARD CHRISTCHURCH SPEED MANAGEMENT STRATEGY

Mrs Yvonne Palmer, Chairperson of the Shirley/Papanui Community Board, on behalf of the Board, sought a delay in the proposal to recommend an increase in the speed limit on Main North Road. She noted that traffic volumes will be greater with the increasing number of subdivisions north of Belfast. The speed of traffic was making it difficult for pedestrians to cross Main North Road at QEII Drive, Johns Road, Cranford Street and at the Styx Mill Bridge. The Community Board submission was considered together with Clause 15 of the Committee's agenda.
