The purpose of this report is to ask that the Council consider the installation of a P60 parking restriction outside Nos 276 to 284, and 281 to 289 Greers Road, as shown on the **following** plan.

## **BACKGROUND**

A request was received from one of the shopkeepers to extend the existing P60 parking area. After consultation with the Parking Unit a publicity pamphlet was distributed to forty-four property occupants and owners along both sides of Greers Road from Wairakei Road to Saffron Street to determine how they felt about this proposal.

Responses showed that there was: -

- Unqualified support from twelve respondents.
- Qualified support from two respondents.
- One objection without conditions
- And two objections with conditions.

## **PROPOSAL**

In acknowledgment of these responses the existing P60 parking restriction in Greers Road is proposed to be extended on both sides from Nos. 276 to 284, and 281 to 289.

## **Recommendation:**

That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of sixty minutes on both sides of Greers Road, Monday to Saturday from 8.00am to 6.00pm. The restriction on the east side to commence at the southern boundary of No.276 and extend in a northerly direction to the northern boundary of No.284 Greers Road. The restriction on the west side to commence at the southern boundary of No.281 and extend in a northerly direction to the northern boundary of No.289 Greers Road.
