

13. HEATHCOTE VALLEY COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION LETTER

The Board considered a letter received from the Heathcote Valley Community Association expressing concern over a potential danger to cyclists in the area where the Tunnel Road passes over Port Hills Road leaving a very narrow accessway under the bridge. The letter also suggested the construction of a separate cycle track through private land.

The letter had been referred to the Council's Cycle Planning Officer, who had replied to the Heathcote Valley Community Association advising of the Council's awareness of the concerns expressed, and that plans for remedial work had been built into the long-term Cycle Network Plan but that there were insufficient resources available at the moment to take immediate action.
