

4. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

(a) St Albans Tennis Club

Steve Higgs and David Sheppard addressed the Board in relation to the St Albans Tennis Club's project to resurface and upgrade all six tennis courts at its site in Dover Street. This was to be achieved in three stages and an outline of the proposal, with costings, was tabled at the meeting.

They explained that the club was currently targeting older people to take up the sport.

Board members offered several suggestions for alternative sources of funding and also volunteered to write any letters of support for the club.

The Board **decided** that the St Albans Tennis Club's application for funding be referred to the Special Meeting in March to allocate Project Funds.

(b) McVicars Treatment Facility – Resource Consent Application to Canterbury Regional Council

Joy Delis of Johns Road spoke about and tabled concerns in relation to the McVicars application to discharge stormwater into the ground. She asked for Community Board support in their opposition to the application.

The Board **decided** that staff be asked to investigate the application and if necessary a subcommittee meet to make a recommendation to the Council.
