32. WOOSH FUNDING REQUEST

The Board considered a request for the allocation of up to \$5,000 from the Out of School Programme fund of \$17,478.35 to WOOSH (Waltham Out of School Hours). The reasons for the funding request are:

- WOOSH is currently experiencing a severe funding shortfall for term one which would cause closure of the programme.
- WOOSH serves a decile one school and the low socio-economic area of Waltham and as such is a much needed community service.
- WOOSH is making a substantial effort to improve its financial viability by increasing the pricing structure of the programme seeking business sponsorship and increasing parental awareness of the WINZ Oscar subsidy.

The Board **resolved** to allocate \$4,315 to WOOSH from the 1998/99 Out of School Programme Project funds subject to the following conditions:

- 1. That WOOSH not downsize.
- 2. That WOOSH develop a long term financial strategy with the assistance of appropriate staff.
- 3. That WOOSH encourage parents who are eligible for the WINZ Oscar subsidy allowance to claim.
- 4. That the Community Development Adviser or Assistant Community Development Adviser be eligible/invited to WOOSH management committee meetings and receive monthly minutes.
- 5. That WOOSH adopt the increased charging structure.
