

8. EDIBLE FRUIT AND NUT TREES ON PARKS

A report from the Area Parks Officer and Senior Landscape Architect requested the Board to identify a park in its area from the short-list provided, to undertake a trial planting of edible fruit and nut trees. A sum of \$600 was available for the trial.

Mention was also made about using planting species other than those suggested in the report. Examples cited included Ginkgo Biloba and kiwi fruit vines.

It was **decided** that Jeffreys Park and Hyde Park be selected for the planting of edible fruit and nut trees.
