4. CORRESPONDENCE

4.1 REDCLIFFS PARK – SKATEBOAD AREA – HALF COURT

The Board considered a letter from Mrs M O Rule, expressing concern that funding had been provided for the construction of a skateboard area in Redcliffs Park in the 2000/2001 financial year without consultation thus far with residents of the area.

The Board considered that a clear commitment could be given to Mrs Rule that wide consultation would take place with the community before this project would proceed.

The Board **decided** that the Community Advocate send a suitable reply to Mrs Rule.

4.2 WALK OF FAME

The Board considered a letter from the Secretary of the Sumner/Ferrymead Foundation proposing a project called the "Walk of Fame" along the walkway between Cave Rock and Scarborough Hill.

The proposal was that plaques be placed in the sea wall along this footpath with the names of persons with a Sumner connection who had made significant contributions to the community.

The Board **decided** to respond to the Sumner/Ferrymead Foundation with a letter which would convey the following points:

- (a) The Board's congratulations on this initiative.
- (b) The advice that the Community Board supports this proposal in principle (although this expression of support does not imply an automatic approval to proceed with the installation of these plaques on the wall).
- (c) That more information on this proposal be sought and that the Sumner/Ferrymead Foundation be asked in what specific way the Community Board can assist it with this project.
- (d) That the letter ask what consultation the Foundation is taking with their community in this project and asking them also to ensure that the appropriate Council Units, and in particular the Parks Unit, are consulted on this proposal.
- (e) That advice be sought on how the Foundation proposes to select those to be commemorated in this "Walk of Fame".
