## 1. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

## 1.1 "It's great to live here."

The Rev Lyndsey McKay, Minister of the Linwood Avenue Union Church, addressed the Board inviting Board members to attend the celebration "It's great to live here", planned in the Eastgate Mall between 20 and 24 July 1999 to celebrate the concept that it is great to live on the east side of the city.

This celebration was planned for the Centre Court in the Eastgate Mall.

The Board **decided** to appoint Erin Baker, John Freeman, Liz McRostie, Linda Rutland and Bob Todd to a Working Party to liaise with the Linwood Avenue Union Church about this celebration.

## 1.2 NUT AND FRUIT TREES IN CHRISTCHURCH

Councillor Barbara Stewart briefed the Board on one proposal from the Council's "Creativity Team" which was that nut and fruit trees be planted in selected city parks. Councillor Stewart advised that the Council has allocated \$6,000 for this project, which is \$1,000 to each Community Board area.

Councillor Stewart asked the Board to determine its preferred park and tree types in consultation with the Parks Unit.
