

14. EDIBLE FRUIT AND NUT TREES ON PARKS

The Board considered a report seeking the identification of a park within the Board's area for a trial planting of edible fruit and nut trees.

In the discussion it was suggested that self-pollinating cherry trees could appropriately be added to the suggested list of trees. The Board believed it would be appropriate to seek advice on this proposal from the Area Parks Officer on such matters as the likely availability of trees, their likely size when available, and the ultimate height and spread of these trees when fully grown.

The Board **resolved**:

1. That the reserve at 84 Stanmore Road and at the corner of Tuam Street and Stanmore Road be the preferred locations for these plantings.
2. That the Linwood Neighbourhood Committee be approached and consulted on this matter.
3. That the Area Parks Officer be authorised to investigate appropriate trees for these plantings.
