

#### 14. HAYNES AVENUE PARKING RESTRICTIONS

The Works and Traffic Committee was in receipt of a report from the Engineer in which he sought approval to install a parking restriction covering a section of Haynes Avenue.

A request has been received from the “Lady May Kindergarten” in Haynes Avenue for a short term parking restriction directly outside their property.

The problem is that staff from the nearby Countdown Supermarket in Hansons Lane are parking for long periods in Haynes Avenue. This long term parking often extends along the kindergarten frontage. This causes problems for parents that want to park outside the kindergarten to drop off and pick up their children, particularly during inclement weather.

The problem can be overcome by installing a short term parking restriction covering the immediate frontage of the kindergarten (5 spaces). A ten minute maximum time limit is proposed.

The Board **resolved** that the parking of vehicles be limited to maximum of ten minutes on the north side of Haynes Avenue from a point 115 metres west of the Hansons Lane intersection and extending 25 metres in a westerly direction.
