15. MIDDLEPARK ROAD AT ST THOMAS OF CANTERBURY COLLEGE

The Works and Traffic Committee was in receipt of a report from the Community Engineer in which he sought the financial assistance of the Board to construct the proposed traffic calming devices on Middlepark Road at St Thomas of Canterbury College.

The Board had a recommendation of the previous meeting which states as follows:

"That the proposal for two road narrowing works, with associated asphalt humps, be considered by the College and local community in the first instance"

The option has since been considered by the school and their support has been obtained. The project now needs to be advanced to the public consultation stage. Before embarking on this stage funding needs to be secured. This is important so that the public is clear that the Council has intentions to proceed with the work

The Wadeley Road project, which is well underway, will cost the Board \$30,000. This will leave a surplus in the "Traffic Restraints R/W" allocation of \$15,000. This is likely to be the approximate cost of the proposed works on Middlepark Road. The Committee agreed that the funding should be secured from the Wadeley Road surplus.

The Board **resolved:**

- 1. That \$15,000 from the surplus Wadeley Road project funds be allocated to the Middlepark Road project.
- 2. That subject to 1 above, a publicity leaflet be distributed to the local community seeking their views on the project the result of which to be reported back to the Board through the Works and Traffic Committee.
