

**6. REPORT OF THE ZONE 5 MEETING OF
LOCAL GOVERNMENT NEW ZEALAND**

The Chairman reported on the Zone 5 meeting which took place on Friday 28 May 1999. The meeting covered a number of issues of relevance to the Council, including:

- driver licensing
- waste minimisation
- local government new zealand executive report on reviews of local government functions by central government
- road reform
- small business enterprise centres
- fencing of swimming pools
- rural firefighting

The Committee **decided**:

1. That the information be received.
2. That staff give consideration to the Hurunui proposal for joint newspaper advertising to warn pool owners of their responsibilities.
3. That staff also explore opportunities for joining with other local authorities to publicise pool owners' responsibilities in terms of the fencing of swimming pools.
