

13. ANNUAL BURWOOD/PEGASUS RESIDENTS' ASSOCIATIONS ACCOUNTABILITY STUDY

The Community Development Adviser reported on information received from the Annual Burwood/Pegasus Residents' Associations Accountability Study. The Board **decided:**

1. To receive the information.
