#### 6. CORRESPONDENCE

# 6.1 FURTHER SUBMISSIONS ON THE VARIATIONS 1-9 OF THE REGIONAL COASTAL ENVIRONMENT PLAN

A letter was received from L R McCallum, Natural Resources Planning Manager, Canterbury Regional Council outlining the processes for further submissions to the Proposed Regional Coastal Environment Plan. The Board **decided** that the Chairperson and Community Advocate consider its submissions and make cross submissions where appropriate.

# 6.2 FUNDING FOR SEASIDE RADIO 88 FM
