## 20. CANTERBURY REGIONAL COUNCIL: PARTICIPATION WITH CANTERBURY WASTE SUBCOMMITTEE RR 9489

The Committee received a request from the Canterbury Regional Council with regard to a working party model to address hazardous waste management issues in Canterbury. Committee members noted that reports from the Canterbury Waste Subcommittee and the Christchurch City Council/Canterbury Regional Council Joint Standing Committee had included references to a proposed working party model. The reports had been submitted to the Council meeting in May and gained the Council's support. It will be recalled that the working party membership adopted by the May meeting was two representatives of the Canterbury Regional Council, one member representing northern local authorities, one City Council representative and a representative of southern local authorities.

The Regional Council had now proposed a larger working party including representatives of all councils in the Canterbury Region. The Regional Council did however indicate that should the new proposal not be supported that the Canterbury Waste Subcommittee's proposal would be supported.

## It was resolved:

- 1. That the Canterbury Regional Council be advised that the working party model proposed by the Canterbury Waste Subcommittee is consistent with the established policy of the Council adopted in May 1999.
- 2. That a representative be appointed to the working party.
- 3. That Councillor Denis O'Rourke be the Council's representative.
