

2. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

The following residents were granted speaking rights to address the Board regarding the proposed provision of bus stops, as part of the new cross suburban bus route service.

Ms Jay McGregor was also in attendance and, with the permission of the meeting, spoke in support of the submission presented by Mr and Mrs Sanders.

The residents' concerns covered the following:

- lack of consultation on the proposal;
- proposed placement of bus stops and resultant security and privacy issues;
- perceived devaluation of properties;
- difficulty with ingress and egress to properties;
- increased traffic density, traffic and pedestrian hazards;
- short and long term health and safety issues,
- the non-inclusion of Bishopdale Mall in the route.

Having considered the information presented, the Board **decided** that a meeting between the Fendalton/Waimairi Community Board, the Chairman of the City Services Committee of the Christchurch City Council, appropriate Canterbury Regional Council elected members and staff from both Councils be sought to discuss the bus stop issues in light of the residents' concerns expressed at the Special Board meeting of 2 June 1999.
