23. COMMUNITY ADVOCATE'S UPDATE

GREEN OPEN SPACE INVESTIGATION

The Board had requested an opportunity to consider the possibility of Council purchase of properties to be used for green open space in areas where there is an identified need. It was proposed that a working party be set up to hold discussions with the appropriate Council Units, to review the processes and clearly to identify the difficulties in making progress on this issue.

The purpose of this investigation would be to propose a process that would enable suitable land to be purchased when it became available.

The Board **resolved** to establish a working party of Bob Todd, Liz McRostie and Aaron O'Brien to undertake the investigation outlined in this report.
