

## 6. CORRESPONDENCE

### 6.1 FUNDING FOR MILLENNIUM EXCHANGE PROJECT – LINWOOD HIGH SCHOOL

The Board considered a budget for costs for a Millennium Exchange Project between Linwood High School and Twynham School, Christchurch, Dorset. Board discretionary funding had been sought to support this exchange project.

Concern was expressed by Board members that ratepayer money is not usually given for this sort of project and that this could establish a precedent.

It was suggested that the Board could seek other ways of helping this applicant with funding.

The Board **decided** that this application for funding be declined with regret.

### 6.2 BROMLEY COMMUNITY RESIDENTS' ASSOCIATION

The Board considered a letter from the Bromley Community Residents' Association, expressing appreciation for the opportunity to attend Community Board meetings and advising of the meeting dates for the regular meetings of the Association.

The Board **received** the information.

### 6.3 CHRISTCHURCH PETANQUE ASSOCIATION INC

The Board considered a letter from the Christchurch Petanque Association Inc seeking promotional funding of \$543.

In discussion it was suggested that the Association may wish to contact the Redcliffs Bowling Club which is also setting up a petanque facility.

The Board **decided** that this application for funding be declined.

### 6.4 INNER CITY EAST NEIGHBOURHOOD GROUP (ICENG)

The Board considered the minutes of a meeting of the Inner City East Neighbourhood Group which had been submitted for information.

The Board **received** the information.
