## 10. CLASSIFICATION OF MARY DUNCAN PARK

The Parks Manager reported recommending that Mary Duncan Park be classified as a recreation reserve under Section 17 of the Reserves Act 1977. Mary Duncan Park is situated on a spur of the Port Hills between Horotane and Avoca Valleys.

The reserve is made up of the following eight parcels of land being parts Rural Sections 388, 10027 and 9640, containing 15.3805 hectares or thereabouts; parts Rural Section 388 containing 3,136 sq m or thereabouts; and parts Rural Section 388, 10027, 10520, and 12479, containing 8.1771 hectares or thereabouts, Canterbury Registry.

The Committee **resolved** that Mary Duncan Park be classified as a Recreation Reserve pursuant to section 17 of the Reserves Act 1977.
