The purpose of this report is to correct minor errors in the City Plan.

A number of minor errors have been discovered in the Proposed Plan as a result of the Plan being amended to incorporate the Council's decisions. The Resource Management Act enables the Council to amend its proposed plan, without further formality, to correct minor errors and to alter any information where this would have a minor effect.

Part 2, Living Zones, 3.4.4 Special setback provisions pg2/31

In the amended version of the Plan following sub-clause (ii) there is an exception clause for that section of Marshland Road between Queen Elizabeth Drive and Briggs Road. The cross reference for this exception clause included in the Plan is inaccurate as it refers to subclauses 3.4.5(b)(i) and (ii) when the reference should be 3.4.4 (b)(i) and (ii). The amendment is of a minor nature and occurred as a result of the re-numbering of clauses in the Plan.

Part 11 Health and Safety, Schedule 2- Zone groupings for hazardous substances pg 11/25

In the amended version of the Plan the Special Purpose Hospital Zone is not listed in any zone grouping in Schedule 2. The Special Purpose Hospital Zone was, however, listed under Group 4 in the Plan as originally proposed. No Council decision amended the Plan by deleting this zone from the schedule and no variation has been advertised which would have deleted the zone from the schedule. The omission is simply a typographical error that occurred in the formatting of the amended version of the Plan.

Recommendation: That the Council resolve to amend the Proposed Christchurch City District Plan, pursuant to Clause 16(2) of the First Schedule to the Resource Management Act 1991, in accordance with the attached amendments (see Appendix A).
