14. 1999/2000 COMMUNITY BOARD PROJECT FUND ALLOCATION

Following deliberation through the Board's Finance and Policy Committee members gave consideration to the recommended schedule of projects for project funding.

One such recommended project related to a request from the Canterbury/Westland Racing Owners Association who were establishing a racing museum at Riccarton Park Raceway.

The Sockburn Service Centre had, until recently, had an involvement with the Chokebore Lodge (an early horse owner's cottage), but the artefacts from the cottage had been transferred to the Racing Club.

In respect of the Association's request for a \$1,500 grant from the Board (as recommended by its Finance and Policy Committee) Bob Shearing **moved**:

"That the Board approves the allocation of Project and Discretionary Funds for 1999/2000, as per the recommended schedule, with the exception of the Canterbury/Westland Racing Owners Association receiving no funding".

The motion was seconded by Mary Corbett and, when put to the vote, was declared **lost** on Division No 1, the voting being

- For (4) Mary Corbett, Bob Shearing, Paddy Austin and Neville Bennett
- Against (5) David Buist, Helen Broughton, Mike Mora, Ishwar Ganda and the Chairperson's casting vote.

Helen Broughton then **moved**:

"that the Board approves the allocation of Project and Discretionary Funds for 1999/2000, as per the recommended schedule, with the exception of the Canterbury/Westland Racing Owners Association receiving \$1,000".

This was seconded by Ishwar Ganda and, when put to the vote, was **lost** on a show of hands by two votes to five votes.

The Board then **resolved**:

1. To allocate \$3,000 from its 1998/99 Discretionary Fund to the Community Development Network Trust for the continued provision of youth recreation programmes.

- 2. To rescind the previous Board resolution to allocate 1999/2000 funds to the Year 2000 Reserve Fund, at this time.
- 3. To allocate 1999/2000 Project and Discretionary Funds, as follows:
