10. WORKS AND TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE - REPORT OF 22 APRIL 1999

At its meeting on 22 April, the Committee undertook site visits to meet with local residents and skateboarding representatives regarding the proposed skatepark facility at Jellie Park and this was followed with a site visit to meet representatives from St Stephens Church on matters associated with the proposed changes to the Ilam/Aorangi Roads intersection.

A concept plan for the planting project in Memorial Avenue was further reviewed and the south carpark at the Bishopdale Shopping Centre and the publicity pamphlet for a pedestrian refuge in Grahams Road were also addressed.

It was noted that Sally Buck had been unable to attend the meeting and had tendered her apologies accordingly.

On the various matters referred to above, the Board **decided** as follows:

Jellie Park Skatepark Facility

That having taken into account the feedback from the consultation, Site F be confirmed for the skatepark facility on Jellie Park and further that detailed plans and costings now be prepared and reported back to the Board.

Ilam/Aorangi Roads Intersection Changes

That the Ilam/Aorangi intersection improvements be deferred and that the Area Engineer be asked to provide further design assistance to the Church if necessary, and that funding options to enable the Church to complete its improvements be investigated and reported back to the Board.

Memorial Avenue Planting Project

- 1. That an invitation be extended to CIAL and the Christchurch Beautifying Association to meet with the Committee to further discuss the planting project at which costings and overall involvement in the various project stages are to be considered.
- 2. That the Board prepare a submission to the Draft 1999 Council Plan requesting that priority be given to the Turning Point 2000 highway planting initiative as it relates to the Memorial Avenue/Russley Road intersection.

Bishopdale Mall Carpark (South)

That a site visit to the Bishopdale Mall carpark be a subject for inclusion on the agenda for the next meeting of the Committee.
