

25. CRIMSON TRAIL: POHUTAKAWA PLANTING PROJECT

The Board considered a report seeking approval for the concept of the Crimson Trail Pohutakawa planting project. This project had been submitted to the Parks Unit by the Sumner/Ferrymead Foundation.

The Board extended speaking rights to Mr Barry Robertson, the Chairman of the Sumner/Ferrymead Foundation, who spoke in support of this proposal.

The Board **resolved:**

1. That the proposal from the Sumner/Ferrymead Foundation to initiate a Crimson Trail of Pohutakawa trees planted at locations to be identified from the Ferrymead Bridge to Taylors Mistake be supported by the Board, subject to public consultation taking place on the individual sites.
2. That, at an appropriate time, the Board give consideration to providing the sum of \$1,000 from its discretionary fund to this project in the 1999/2000 year.
