

7. TRUCK ART DRAW

The winner of the Truck Art Competition was drawn at the meeting. The competition, which was a joint initiative of the City Streets and Water Services Units, was open to third and fourth form high school students who competed for the chance to have their artwork placed on the sides of the City Streets litter trucks and two Water Services floating litter traps. The four winning works were displayed at the meeting.

All schools who entered in the competition were eligible for the main prize, a software package of their choice, valued at \$3,000. This prize was drawn at the Committee meeting. The winning school was Christ's College.

In addition the schools the winning artists came from received \$500 and the winning artist received a "super saver" booklet of 10 movie tickets valued at \$80.
