

3. FERRYMEAD HISTORIC PARK: LAND ISSUES

The Property Projects Officer (Steve McCarroll) submitted a progress report regarding the various land issues associated with Ferrymead Historic Park. Also considered were the submissions made earlier in the meeting by Mr Roy Hughes on behalf of Radio Ferrymead. Mr McCarroll advised that the Council was contractually bound to provide Radio Ferrymead with its own site with separate title, and that the favoured site was located in front of the existing tram barns. It was proposed to submit a fuller report on this and associated Ferrymead land issues to the June meeting of the Committee, although it was anticipated that the associated zoning issues might take longer to resolve.

The Committee **received** the report and requested that a further report on the proposed allocation of the subject site to Radio Ferrymead be submitted to the June meeting of the Committee.
