The purpose of this report is to seek approval for the installation of a bus stop on Langdons Road near the entrance to the Mall.

For the new cross city bus route the Canterbury Regional Council has requested that a bus stop be located on the northern side of Langdons Road, to be a terminal location for the new service, and to provide direct access for patrons to the Northlands Mall.

The most suitable location for this bus stop is to the east of the present vehicle access to the Mall car park. The Mall management have been approached and have inspected the location. They have proposed the siting of the bus stop along this part of their Langdons Road frontage.

Installation of the stop in this location would remove four kerbside car parking spaces from the area which has a 30 minute time restriction. While this area is used intensively, the Mall management sees advantages for vehicles leaving their site in having a clear area between the entrance and the stop. This would also fit in with most options for the future slip road development currently being worked through.

Langdons Road is classified as a Collector road.

- Recommendation:**
1. That the 30 minute time limit vehicle parking restriction on the northern side of Langdons Road be revoked commencing at a point 34 metres in an easterly direction from its intersection with Restell Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 24 metres.
 2. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited on the northern side of Langdons Road commencing at a point 34 metres in an easterly direction from its intersection with Restell Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 12 metres.
 3. That a Bus Stop be installed on the northern side of Langdons Road commencing at a point 46 metres in an easterly direction from its intersection with Restell Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 12 metres.
 4. That this matter come back to the Community Board after six months of operation.
