3. CORRESPONDENCE

3.1 PERIODIC DETENTION CENTRE IN HAMPSHIRE STREET

The Board considered a letter from Lianne Dalziel, MP, to the Department of Corrections. A copy of this letter had been forwarded to the Board for its information. The Board **decided** to write a strong letter to the Minister of Corrections expressing its concerns at the proposed Periodic Detention Centre in Hampshire Street.

3.2 PAGES ROAD - BEXLEY ROUNDABOUT TO NEW BRIGHTON BRIDGE

A letter was received from Michael Knight, Bexley Residents' Association, regarding the condition of the road between the Pages/Bexley Road roundabout and the New Brighton bridge. The Board **decided** to draw the City Streets Manager's attention to the poor condition of sections of Pages Road and urge that additional funds be made available at the six monthly budget review to upgrade the road.

3.3 KINGSLEA RESIDENTIAL CENTRE - THEATRE FOR CHANGE
