

**5. VIEW TERRACE STOPPING –
PEDESTRIAN AND TRAFFIC CONCERNS**

The purpose of this report is to inform the Council of the outcome of the subcommittee meeting on 8 October 1999. In view of the difficult terrain and the safe traffic management of View Terrace by motor vehicles movement from Huntsbury Hill to Centaurus Road be restricted to authorised vehicles only ie residents' cars and service vehicles and further recommends that a barrier sympathetic to the existing environment be constructed at the top of View Terrace.

At the September Committee meeting four options were tabled to resolve some of the concerns raised by the residents and they were:

- Option 1 – Barrier on View Terrace
- Option 2 – Footpath on View Terrace
- Option 3 – Footpath on Huntsbury
- Option 4 – Markings at intersection on Huntsbury Avenue

The report to the meeting is tabled. The same report was also considered by the Spreydon/Heathcote Community Board and its recommendation to the Committee was to implement Options 1 and 3.

The September meeting recommended that a sub-committee be appointed (comprising Councillors O'Rourke, Howell and Thompson) to select a proposal for public consultation. The Subcommittee's recommendation below was adopted by the Committee.

- Recommendation:**
1. That Option 1 be implemented and Option 3 be considered by the Board in its prioritisation of new works in the area.
 2. That the Council prepare a bylaw limiting the use of this portion of View Terrace prior to the barrier being installed.
