

**6. WORKS AND TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMITTEE -  
REPORT OF 12 OCTOBER 1999**

The Board considered the report and accompanying recommendations from the Committee and made the following **decisions**.

**THE ORBITER – RATIONALISATION OF GREERS ROAD BUS STOPS** RR 10760

The outcome in respect of 2(b) below arose from the presentation of a supplementary report from officers reaffirming traffic safety concerns associated with placing a bus stop outside No. 409 Greers Road.

The placement of a bus stop outside Nos 405/407 Greers Road was therefore preferred.

It was **agreed** that the officers visit the residents affected to explain the basis of the Board's recommendation on 2(b) to the City Services Committee.

The Board therefore **decided**:

1. That the submissions from the local residents be received.
2. That it be recommended to the City Services Committee:
  - (a) That a bus stop be installed on the western side of Greers Road commencing at a point 49 metres from its intersection with Kilburn Street and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 13.5 metres (363/365 Greers Road).
  - (b) That a bus stop be installed on the western side of Greers Road commencing at a point 22 metres from its intersection with Eastling Street and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 18 metres (405/407 Greers Road).
3. That the Canterbury Regional Council be asked to initiate a route variation to include the Bishopdale Shopping Centre.

Note: Keith Nuttall declared an interest in and withdrew from the meeting during the consideration of this item, when Barbara Stewart as Deputy Chairman temporarily assumed the chair.
