

11. CORRESPONDENCE

11.1 ADVERTISING BUS SHELTER – CLIFTON BAY

At its previous meeting the Board had decided to withdraw its approval for an advertising bus shelter at Clifton Bay, as it understood that the Sumner Residents' Association did not support this shelter.

The Board considered a letter which had been received from Mrs Shirley Fairhall, Chairperson of the Sumner Residents' Association, advising that the Association had no objection to the replacement of the bus shelter in Clifton Bay with one of the new "advertising type" bus shelters.

The Board **resolved** to approve the erection of an advertising bus shelter in Clifton Bay and to advise George Hadley, Transport Planner: Passenger Transport, of this decision.

11.2 FUNDING FOR HERITAGE BUILDING

The Board considered a letter from Mrs E M Westlake, Secretary/Treasurer of the Brockworth Homestead Project of Heritage Youth Inc, seeking a grant of \$3,000 from the Board's Discretionary Fund towards the cost of relocating the Brockworth Homestead from Riccarton to the environs of Ferrymead Historic Park, to serve as the headquarters building for the Heritage Youth Project.

The Board **resolved** to make a grant of \$3,000 towards the Heritage Youth Inc project to relocate Brockworth House from Riccarton to Ferrymead, to be funded from the Board's 1999/2000 discretionary fund and that, if this project does not go ahead, the \$3,000 grant be repayable to the Community Board.
