The purpose of this report is to request approval from the Projects and Property Committee for the prioritisation of the 1999/2000 budget provision (as delegated by Council at its meeting held on 28 October 1999).

1. BACKGROUND

The Corporate Plan 1999 edition includes a budget provision of \$496,681 for the year 1999/2000 for "bedding in" and additional FF&E items identified some time ago.

The figure of \$496,681 has been increased by \$13,811 to \$510,492 as the result of the under-expenditure on the main project and as approved by Council at its meeting held on 28 October 1999.

2. WORK ALREADY COMMITTED

\$132,379 of the 1999/2000 budget has already been committed on items such as alterations to the lighting truss, lighting to the stars' room/corporate boxes and cross aisle balustrade alterations.

3. **REMAINING BUDGET**

The remaining budget provision of \$378,113 (\$496,681 + \$13,811 - \$132,379) has been the subject of a prioritising exercise in which NCC (NZ) Limited, the Venue Manager, has fully participated.
