7. SPREYDON LIBRARY PUBLIC CONSULTATION

The Board considered a report advising it of the outcome of the public consultation process relating to the siting of the new Spreydon Library building.

The Chairman reminded Board members that accommodation options for the Spreydon Library is a metropolitan issue. The Board has been involved in consulting with local residents and is now, in turn, being consulted on the community viewpoint. The final decision will be made by the Council. The Chairman emphasised the fact that local residents are divided on this issue.

The Board **received** the information and **decided** to consider it in conjunction with a supplementary report tabled at the meeting, to assist the Board in making its recommendation(s) to the appropriate standing committees.
