13. SISTER CITY RELATIONSHIP WITH INHAMBANE/MAXIXE, MOZAMBIQUE

The Director of Policy submitted a report updating the Committee on progress in developing the friendship relationship with Inhambane/Maxixe.

Following a meeting with the New Zealand High Commissioner to Pretoria (who is also accredited to Mozambique), it was agreed to co-operate with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade to sponsor a female English teacher from Inhambane/Maxixe to come to Christchurch for a year to study English as a second language.

The Committee endorsed this proposal and also a suggestion by Councillor Harrow that staff explore the feasibility of setting up a similar humanitarian link with East Timor.

The Committee **decided**:

- 1. That the Committee note the progress on the project and that staff identify appropriate fundraising and support parties in the community.
- 2. That future reports on the development of the relationship between Christchurch City and Inhambane/Maxixe be referred to the Community Services Committee.
- 3. That the staff report to the Council via the Strategy and Resources Committee on the feasibility of setting up a humanitarian relationship with a town or city in East Timor.
