

3. **BASSETT STREET - NO STOPPING RESTRICTION**

The purpose of this report is to seek the Council’s approval to install a “No Stopping” restriction on the southern side of Travis Road.

Consent has been given under the Resource Management Act to establish and operate a preschool in an existing dwelling at 114 Bassett Street. The preschool would have a maximum of 42 children, and would operate between the hours of 7.30am and 6.00pm Monday to Friday. Five on-site parking spaces have been provided.

The decision of the hearing was that, *“the City Streets Unit of the Council is to paint yellow no stopping lines between the driveway of the application site and the corner of Travis Road and Bassett Street and is to investigate, whether in the interest of traffic safety, yellow no stopping lines should also be painted on the opposite side of Bassett Street. This work should be undertaken prior to the opening of the centre and shall not be at the expense of the applicant”*.

There does not appear to be a need to paint ‘No Stopping’ lines opposite 114 Bassett Street at this time. The location of this site is shown on the attached plan.

Recommendation: That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited (at any time) on the southern side of Travis Road commencing at its intersection with Bassett Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 15 metres.
