The Committee was advised that a pin oak tree was now too close to the facade of the bus interchange. Submissions had been received from the developers requesting that the tree be removed. There was urgency in this matter as work on this section of the interchange was now proceeding. The Committee was advised that the developer may contribute to part of the cost of relocation.

It was **resolved** that the pin oak tree in the City Mall adjacent to the facade of the bus interchange be relocated to a central city site.

(Councillor Robin Booth requested that his vote against this resolution be recorded.)
