9. FAMILY AND COMMUNITY FUNDING APPLICATION

RR 10873

The Committee considered a request for funding from the Family and Community division of Anglican Care for \$30,000 to support its eight community projects.

The Family and Community division works with the more marginalised and atrisk people in the community. Since 1991 it has developed partnerships with the City Council in Linwood, Waltham, Addington, Hornby, North New Brighton, Bryndwr, Aranui and Dallington. Community Boards have provided funding for these projects as part of the partnership agreement.

This report related to funding to assist the provision of professional support and mileage for community workers and salary costs and is a one-off application which is supported in terms of the outcomes of the Community Development and Social Well-being Policy.

As the request was deemed to be "metropolitan" in nature, it was directed to the Community Services Committee for consideration.

The Committee **resolved** to support this application and grant \$30,000 plus GST from Community Well-being Discretionary Funding.
