

36. COMMUNITY FUNDING COMMITTEE

At its meeting on 4 August 1999, the Board had resolved “that the Board investigate whether a representative of Nga Maata Waka (ie Maori groups other than those of Kai Tahu background) should also be appointed to the Community Funding Committee. The Board, at this meeting, appointed a representative of Kai Tahu to the Community Funding Committee.

At an earlier stage of the meeting, the Board had heard representations from Mr Norm Dewes, outlining the need for Nga Maata Waka representation on the Community Funding Committee.

The Board **resolved** that, when a vacancy occurs on the Community Funding Committee, Nga Maata Waka be invited to nominate a representative to be considered alongside other community representatives for appointment to the Community Funding Committee.
