

## 25. REVIEW OF ADVERTISING ON BUS SHELTERS POLICY

The Board considered a report advising the Council's current policy relating to advertising on bus shelters and that this policy was being monitored and reviewed. However, as the Board had already considered the question of the Council's policy on this matter at its previous meeting, the Board wished to make no further comments on the Council policy.

At its meeting 1 September 1999, the Board had resolved to approve a number of specific bus stop advertising shelters which had been submitted originally to the Board for approval at its 4 August 1999 meeting. The list of specific bus stop advertising shelters included one located in Main Road, 20 metres east of Clifton Terrace.

Since this decision was made, Board members have received representations from the Sumner Residents' Association suggesting that this particular location was inappropriate for an advertising bus shelter, although other bus stops in the area might well be suitable. Accordingly, the Board **resolved** that the Board, having heard the concerns of the residents' association, now wishes to withdraw its approval for the advertising bus shelter located in Clifton Bay ie Main Road – 20 metres east of Clifton Terrace.
