

## 12. HOLLISS AVENUE RESIDENTS PETITION

The Board considered a report from the Area Engineer informing it of a petition that had been received from the residents of Holliss Avenue, Gunns Crescent and Glamis Place. There is a significant incidence of excessive speed, probably largely on the part of residents of these same streets.

Mrs Burgess spoke in support of the residents' petition, expressing her concern for children's safety. The area is well used by children with there being a park nearby, as well as Landsdowne Community Centre. All the residents that have been approached are in favour of judder bars.

The Board **resolved**:

1. To investigate in conjunction with staff and residents, the installation of a stop sign in place of the present "give way" sign, and continued random monitoring of the area by the Police,.
2. If there is no improvement in driver behaviour, this item should be re-visited in terms of priority on the road hump list.
