

24. 1998/99 SUMMER WATER SUPPLY ISSUES

RR 10412

This report informed the Committee of the work that is being undertaken as a consequence of the experience gained from the dry 1998/99 summer. The intention is that the Water Supply System will be more robust than in the past, and thus better able to cope with periods of high water demand and/or low groundwater levels in the future. The Water Supply advertising and publicity programme is also being refocused as a result.

It was **decided**:

1. That the themes for the 1999/2000 year Publicity and Promotion on water-related issues as outlined in the report be endorsed.
2. That the detailed publicity programme be presented to the Committee for adoption with cost estimates.
