## 8. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

## (a) MR RICHARD WORRALL

Mr Richard Worrall addressed the Committee on the option of light rail as an alternative for public transport in Christchurch. Mr Worrall had requested speaking rights to present a response to the Booz Allen and Hamilton report entitled "Light Rail Opportunities for Christchurch". Mr Worrall presented a series of overhead projections which covered the following:

Methodology for assessing potential patronage;

Traffic volumes on key arterial routes are in fact great enough to support light rail;

No patronage surveys carried out;

Misuse of generalised patronage data;

Choice of routes;

Mid-street running proposed;

First and second class stops;

Separate depot;

Cost comparisons;

Capital costs;

Light Rail Transit Association ignored for advice;

If it works in Grenoble, why shouldn't it work in Christchurch?

## (b) MR MIKE JOYCE

Mr Mike Joyce requested speaking rights to put forward his proposals for access to the bus interchange and the Arthur Barnett/Cashfields development. Mr Joyce's submissions had been circulated to Committee members prior to the meeting.
