

**11. TUI STREET/ROA ROAD -
KERB AND CHANNEL RENEWAL – UPDATE**

The Area Engineer reported on the feedback received from the distribution of the publicity plan showing the proposed layout for Tui Street and Roa Road.

The report proposed that the work as shown on the plan be implemented with the exception of the angle parking outside Nos. 14-18 Tui Street being replaced with grass berms and street trees.

Although noting the feedback received on this aspect, the view was expressed that activities associated with the nearby St Barnabas Church together with eventual changes on Fendalton Road would place more demand on the need for on-street parking and hence the angle parking outside Nos. 14, 16 and 18 Tui Street should be retained.

A motion to refer the report back to the Board's Works and Traffic Safety Committee for further assessment, when put to the meeting, was declared **lost**.

A further motion calling for the removal of the proposed road humps from the plan, lapsed for want of a seconder.

It was **resolved**:

1. That the proposed works be approved for tendering and construction.
2. That a Give Way sign be placed against Tui Street at its intersection with Fendalton Road.

Keith Nuttall and Ron Wright asked that their votes be recorded against the above decisions.
