

10. CORRESPONDENCE

10.1 HERITAGE BUILDINGS – CATHEDRAL SQUARE

The Board considered a letter received from Sue Stagg, Chairperson of the Avon Loop Planning Association, expressing support for retention of the Star, Lyttelton Times and Warners Hotel buildings in Cathedral Square.

The Board **resolved**:

1. That the information be received.
2. That the letter be forwarded to the Environment Committee.

10.2 EDUCATIONAL SERVICES TRUST

The Board considered a formal letter seeking funding from Mr Sam Farr, Chairman of the Educational Services Trust Inc. The Board had earlier heard submissions in support of this request from Mr Farr and Mr Bruce Scott, a Trustee.

The applicant was seeking funding to refurbish the former Ferrymead Historic Park administration building for use as an accommodation block for out of town schools visiting Ferrymead Historic Park on educational visits.

The Board **resolved** to make a grant of \$3,000 to this project from its 1999/2000 discretionary fund.

10.3 WOOLSTON COMMUNITY CHILDCARE CENTRE – PLAYGROUND UPDATE

The Woolston Community Childcare Centre had written to the Board seeking funding of \$1,000 towards the cost of preparation of a landscape plan to assist with a playground update. The total cost of the landscape plan was \$1,500 and a contribution from the Community Board towards this amount was sought.

The Board **resolved** that a grant of \$1,000 be made to the Woolston Community Childcare Centre to assist in the preparation of a landscape plan from the Board's 1999/2000 discretionary fund, subject to clarification by the Community Advocate of an entry in the budget submitted in support of this application "Union Fees \$1,727."

10.4 CHRISTCHURCH CHILDREN'S HOLIDAY CAMPS TRUST

The Board considered a letter from Mr W B Sykes, Secretary/Treasurer of the Christchurch Children's Holiday Camps Trust, seeking the Board's support by way of funding in the coming year.

The Board **resolved** to provide a grant of \$1,000 to sponsor children from the Hagley and Ferrymead Wards from the 1999/2000 Discretionary Fund.

10.5 SUPPORT FOR OCTOBER HOLIDAY PROGRAMME

The Board considered a letter from Charmain Hubbard, Acting Co-ordinator of the Phillipstown Community Centre, seeking funding of \$800 for the October School Holiday Programme to be run at the Phillipstown Community Centre.

The Board **resolved** that a grant of \$800 be given to the Phillipstown Community Centre for the October School Holiday Programme from the Board's 1999/2000 Discretionary Fund.
