

15. DRIVEWAY – MAIN ROAD, REDCLIFFS

At the 4 August 1999 meeting of the Board Mr John Tweedie, a resident in Main Road, Redcliffs, sought Council funding to widen the vehicle entrance to his property as a result of the location of a pedestrian island immediately outside his driveway.

The Board had resolved to seek an officer's report on this matter. This report was considered by the Board.

The Board **resolved:**

1. That the information be received.
2. That the Board does not support the Council fully funding the alterations to the vehicle crossing to No 81 Main Road.
3. That the broken yellow "no stopping lines" be extended to cover the vehicle entrance to No 81 Main Road.
4. That officers renegotiate the half and half funding of the vehicle crossing.
