4. IMPLEMENTATION AND PRIORITIES OF THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND SOCIAL WELL-BEING POLICY

The Committee considered a report from Mary Richardson, Senior Social Policy Analyst, and Kath Jamieson, Community Adviser Research, informing the Committee of the process for reviewing the implementation of the Community Development and Social Well-being Policy, as requested when the policy was adopted.

The project will include clarification of the roles and the scope identified in the policy and further specification of outcomes so performance measurement is possible. It will develop an operational strategy and identify an on-going monitoring process. Input from elected members will be sought at several stages of the process.

The Committee **decided:**

- 1. To endorse the above process for reviewing the implementation of the Community Development and Social Well-being Policy.
- 2. To note the proposed seminar as a key opportunity to have input into the policy implementation and priorities.
