

## **14. COMMUNITY ADVOCATE'S UPDATE**

### **14.1 NEIGHBOURHOOD IMPROVEMENT WORKS BUDGET**

In response to an earlier enquiry by the Board, confirmation was given that a separate funding allocation was provided to meet the cost of engaging outside consultants to prioritise neighbourhood improvement works.

### **14.2 DISCRETIONARY FUNDING**

The Board considered a schedule detailing the Board's discretionary funding allocations to date, showing a balance remaining for allocation of \$1,188.

### **14.3 AVEBURY HOUSE**

The Board noted that an application had been submitted to the "Requests for Proposals" for the future use of Avebury House.

### **14.4 LIQUOR LICENSING APPLICATIONS**

After discussion, the Board decided to circulate only new or changed liquor license applications relating to residential areas.

### **14.5 COMMUNITY ADVOCATE**

The new Community Advocate, Jude Pani, was welcomed to the meeting. The retiring Community Advocate, Alan Dunlop, who has been transferred to a new post in the Civic Offices, was thanked by the Board for his services as Community Advocate over the past 16 months and wished well in his new position.
