# 1. VARIATION – SPECIAL PURPOSE (AIRPORT) ZONE POLICY – PROPOSED VARIATION: CHRISTCHURCH INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT NOISE ISSUES

A report from the Environmental Services Manager sought approval to undertake work towards a variation for Christchurch International Airport noise issues, including consultation in a section 32 analysis. The variation was not included on the list of priority variations that were agreed by the Council last year, but rather had arisen as a result of a recent declaration affecting two critical policies in the City Plan.

The Committee **resolved** that a variation to the Proposed City Plan (including a section 32 analysis and consultation) be prepared to address the following matters:

- 1. To clarify whether the  $50L_{dn}$  dBA noise contour should be the limit for future residential development towards the Christchurch International Airport.
- 2. To incorporate a requirement that the Christchurch International Airport be operated in such a way that aircraft movements do not exceed the noise levels specified at the air noise boundary  $(65L_{dn} \, dBA)$ .

The meeting concluded at 1.25pm.
