## 13. COMMUNITY BOARD DISCRETIONARY FUND UPDATE

Members were in receipt of an update report on allocations made from the 1999/2000 Discretionary Fund.

With a balance of \$6,540 available the Board **resolved** to make two further allocations:

## Riccarton Community Watch, \$3,200.

With the support of the Police, the Central Riccarton Residents' Association had facilitated public meetings to gauge support for the establishment of a community watch.

The area to be covered is closely aligned to the boundaries of the Riccarton Ward.

Local businesses have supplied a car, and a grant was received from a local service club.

The Community Board has previously given financial support to the Hornby Community Watch.

## Community Information Kiosks Refurbishment \$3,300

Within the Board's area there are three information kiosks:

SH1, Templeton

Main South Road, at Denton Park

Main South Road, opposite the Sockburn Service Centre

The two Main South Road kiosks have never had maintenance/refurbishment undertaken.

With a possible financial contribution from the local service club that built the kiosk at Denton Park, the Board has approved this funding to enable the refurbishment of the two kiosks. Updated community information would now be placed into the kiosks (eg street map and directory, publicity material, and community directory information).
